Minutes of the Previous Board Meeting

The prior month's board meeting minutes were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report

Sheli Nan reviewed the financial report as of May 11, 2022, with ending balances of \$12,290.69 in our bank account and \$1,119.79 in our PayPal account. The Treasurer's Report was approved.

Status of Recent & Upcoming Concerts

John Bilotta presented recent concert information and updated plans for the 2021-22 season.

- Composers & Friends II Saturday, April 9, 8 pm, live at the Center for New Music. The C4NM reported a system crash and has not yet completed editing the video/audio recordings from the concert. C4NM confirmed that the recording files are safe on an external storage device, and they will resume work on the editing. On May 17, C4NM forwarded us \$250 in ticket sales from the concert.
- 2. Presidio Chapel/Cecilia Ensemble Concert Sunday, May 22, 4 pm, in person and livestream, both free. There are ten works on the program five SF and five LA.
- 3. Menlo Brass Quintet Concert Saturday, July 16, 3 pm The Quintet has selected 11 works for performance.
 - a. Ticket prices were discussed and approved by the Board as follows: \$20 General Admission / \$15 Senior & Students / \$10 for NACUSAsf members.
 - b. Comp tickets: 1 comp ticket to each performer and 1 to each composer with a work on the program.
 - c. The Board did not make a firm decision on whether the concert will be recorded or live-streamed or both—or who would do it or how much the organization would spend for it. Mary Feinman offered to contact the Menlo Brass for recording engineer references in the South Bay Area. John will get a quote from Zach Miley if he's available. May 30th is the due date for a decision.
- d. CPE (Pierrot) Concert Saturday, Nov. 5, 8 pm & Sunday, Nov. 6, 3 pm.
 - e. Allan Crossman sent an email that provided information on two performing spaces at Crowden School in Berkeley. A lot of other potential venues around the Bay Area were discussed. No hard decisions were made.
